This Century Art Gallery presents ArtSpeaks: Small & Great, a gala event to celebrate and support the Gallery and recognize many of the professional visual artists in Hampton Roads and beyond. Set for Sunday afternoon, September 15th, at the Williamsburg Community Building, the event brings art and artists together in a unique setting. This year's event, **chaired by Sue Donaldson and Patricia Rublein**, will offer signed works, ready to hang, in various media.

This Century Art Gallery is pleased to have well-known artist, Carlton Abbott, as Chair of the 2013 ArtSpeaks event. Abbott is a founding member and a long time supporter of the projects of the Gallery, now observing 54 years

of commitment to the visual arts in Greater Williamsburg. "As Honorary Chair of this year's event, I am eager to have the participation of many of our area's fine artists. I have been committed over many years to the success of This Century Art Gallery," he said.

Artists have been asked to offer works, ready to display, within a dimension of 16 inches by 16 inches, including any matting and/or framing, or may be mounted on a stretcher form. 3-D work and jewelry will also conform to 16 inches. The new guidelines will enhance the beauty, quality and marketability of the work.

The ArtSpeaks exhibit and sale is scheduled annually as an important part of the fundraising work of This Century Art Gallery. "The Gallery has been a valuable venue for many artists over the years, to have their work displayed and shown to the public," said Sue Donaldson. "We want to be able to continue to offer our community of artists the opportunity to show their work in a quality exhibition environment. Support for this event will help sustain that work." STATE OF THE GALLERY

From the President and Executive Director: The gallery enjoyed a very successful Annual Meeting at The Williamsburg Landing on Monday, May 20, 2013. We had a record attendance of 115 people that included both gallery members and residents of the Landing. The program covered the 2012 Year in Review, Treasurer's Report, Moving Forward in 2013, a Property Update and a special lecture by Carlton Abbott on his latest book "Historical Footprints and the Future." While the entire program was well received, the most significant component involved our purchase of Carlton's property in City Square. Both Tim Caviness and Carlton elaborated on the location and proposed construction of a 7,000 square foot building that will house the future Williamsburg Art Center.

Kerry Mellette expanded on our three key strategic goals for 2013: to increase volunteerism, restructure the board, and increase operating revenue. We are moving to a policy board by creating a committee structure. Our ultimate goal is to fund and sustain the new building which will require the launch of a capital campaign in the future.

As we plan the implementation of these strategic goals, a major focus will be on increasing volunteers to work on new committees that will include Finance, Development, Program/Outreach, and Marketing. However, a list of 20 volunteer opportunities has been created and we would appreciate it if all members will consider giving their time and talent to one or more of them. The majority are short term commitments, so we're not seeking a major investment of your time, but it's a recognized fact that the lifeblood of any non-profit organization is the involvement of its members. Surprise us and yourself with the satisfaction you'll receive by getting involved!

Perhaps one of our greatest challenges going forward is to increase our operating revenue. For the past two years we've enjoyed the benefits of challenge grants by a few members that have essentially funded our part-time staff. These funds are no longer available this year. Consequently, we are hopeful that members will generously support the 2013 Annual Fund. In 2014, plans are underway for "Artful Soiree" fundraising parties that will augment our annual major fundraiser "ArtSpeaks" in the fall.

Other new initiatives include a Business Partners campaign and an expansion of the Weekend Gallery in June, September, and November. The former will help engage the business community in gallery activities and the latter will continue to attract the public, showcase local artists, and provide increased exposure.

As always, we welcome your comments and suggestions. In the meantime, we wish you an enjoyable summer.
